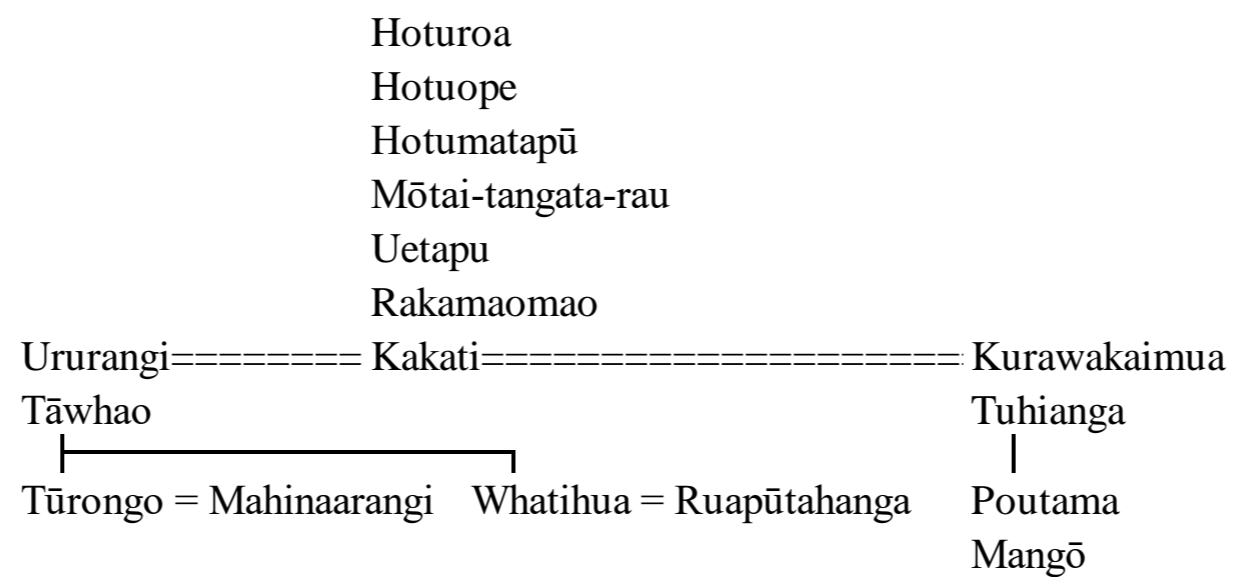

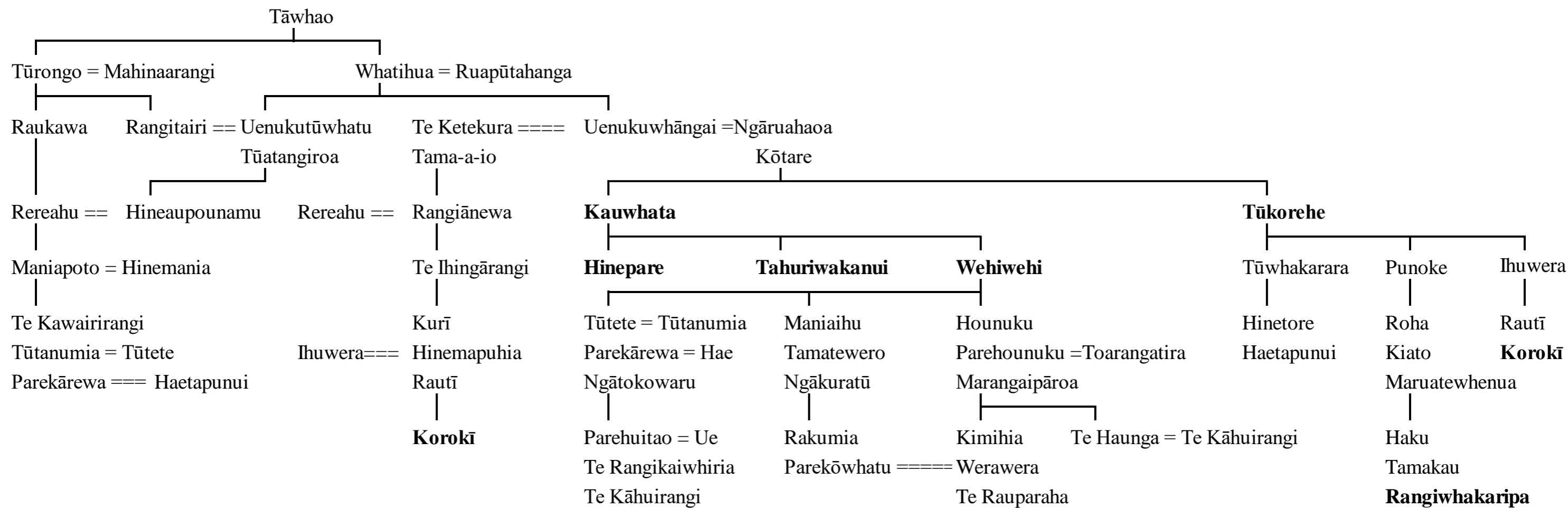

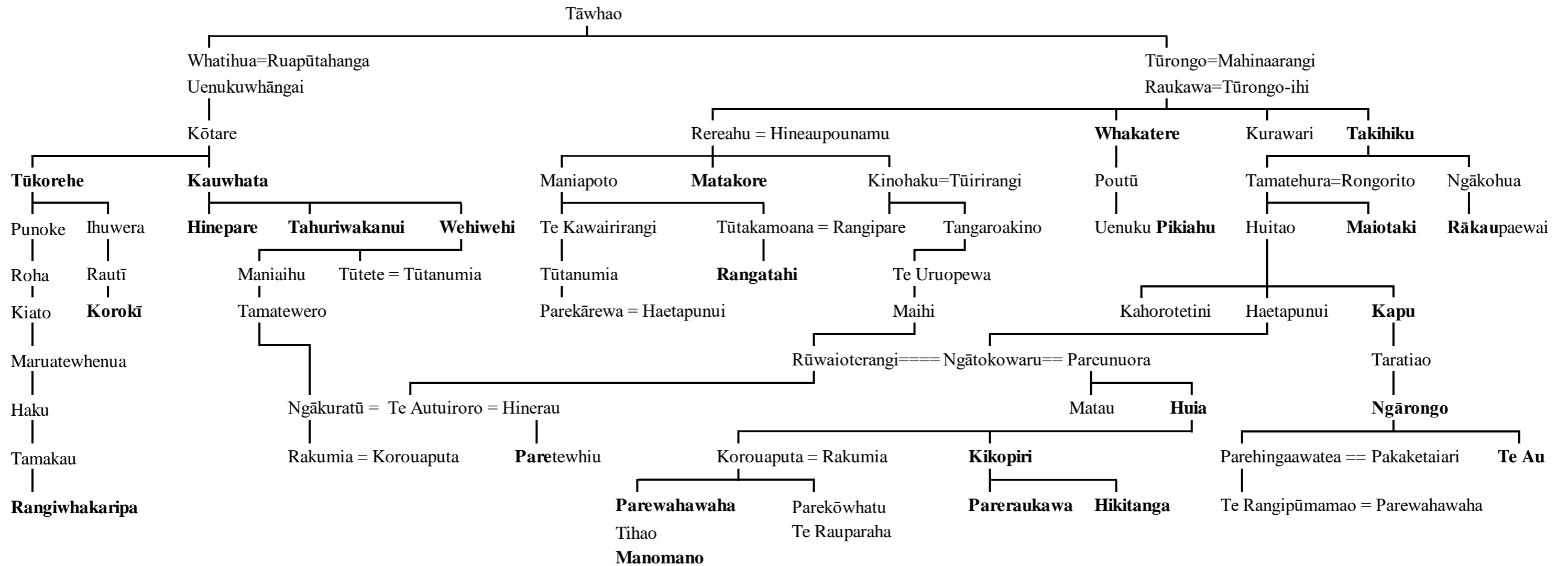

**Whakapapa 1: Descendants of Kakati**

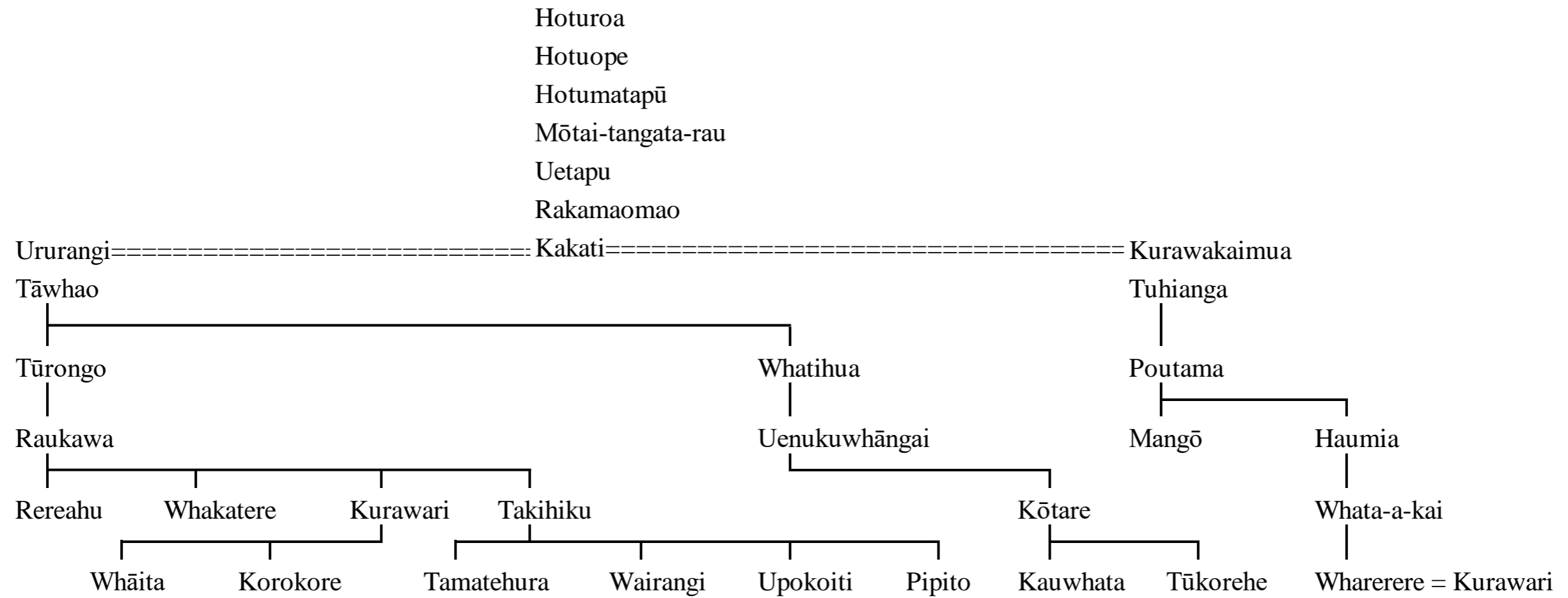


## Whakapapa 2: Descendants of Whatihua

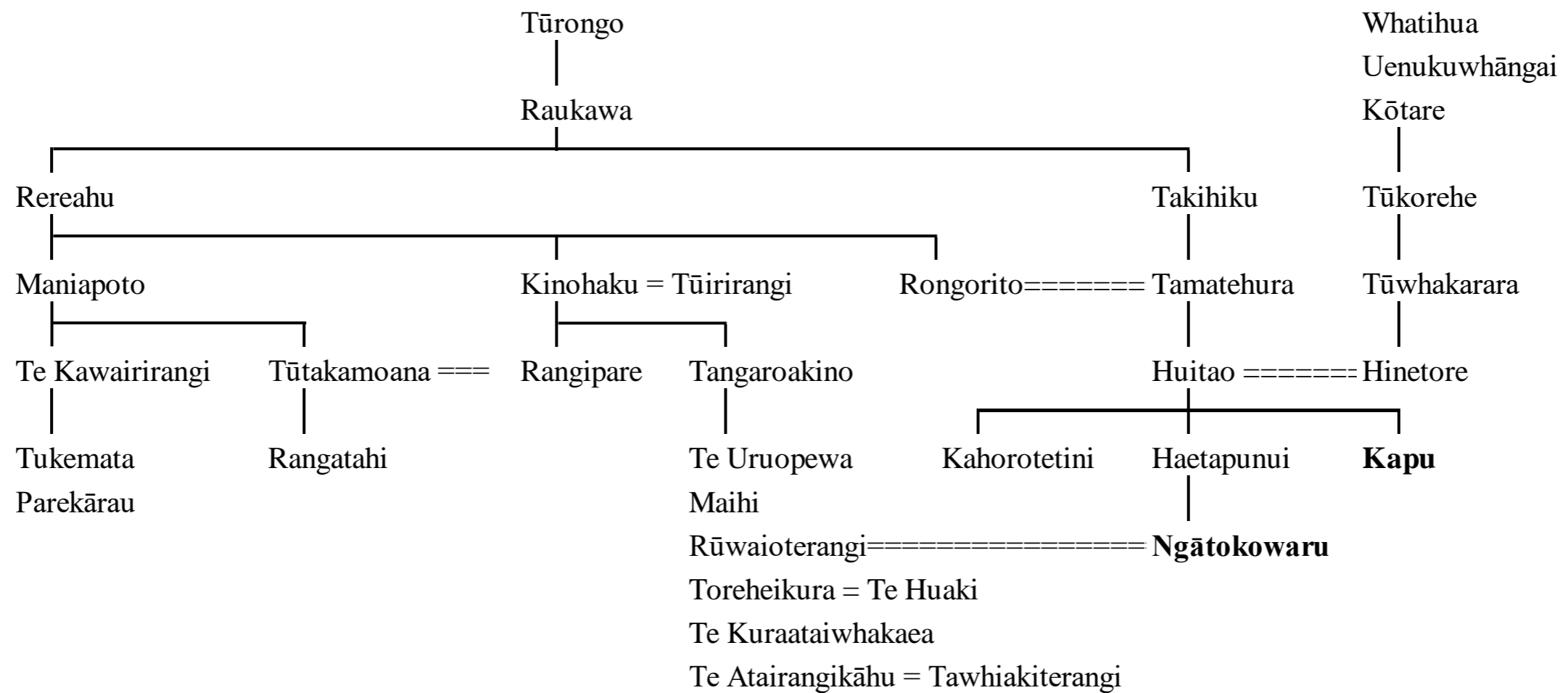


### Whakapapa 3: The Hapū of the Ngāti Raukawa Confederation<sup>1</sup>

The eponymous ancestress, Waewae, is shown in Whakapapa 7.

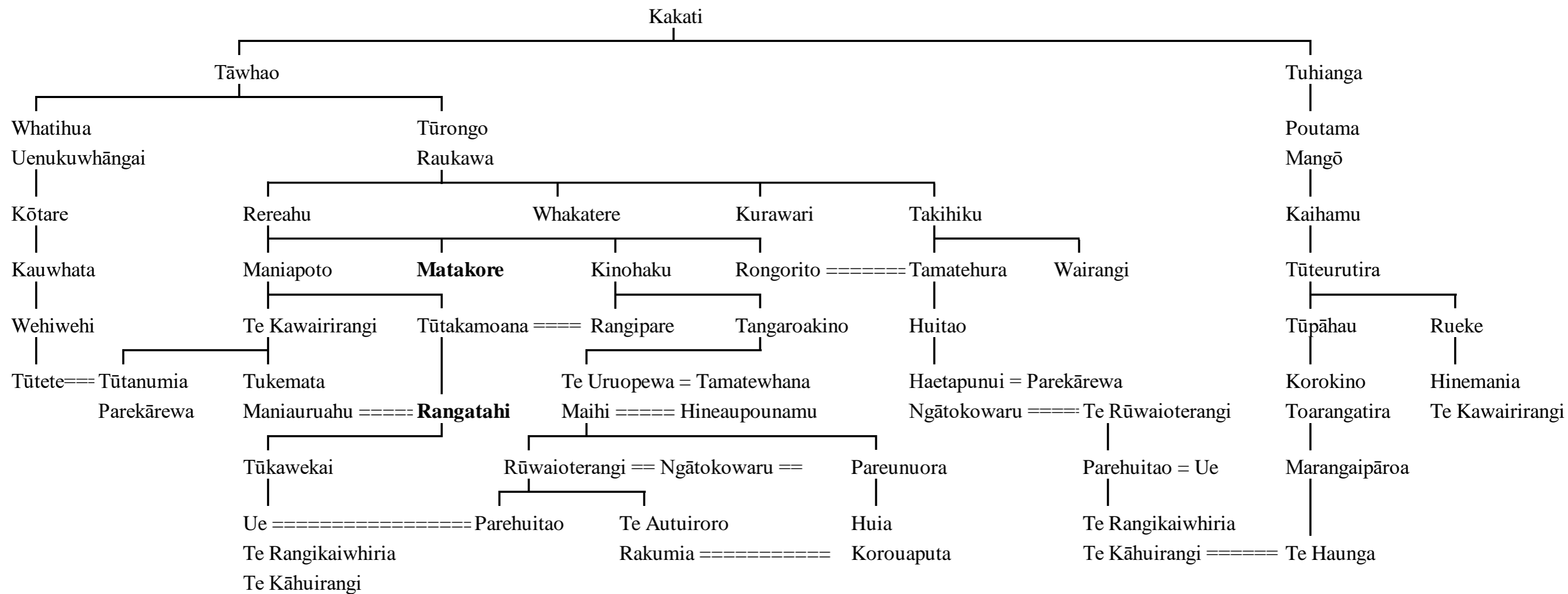


**Whakapapa 4: The Sons of Takihiku**

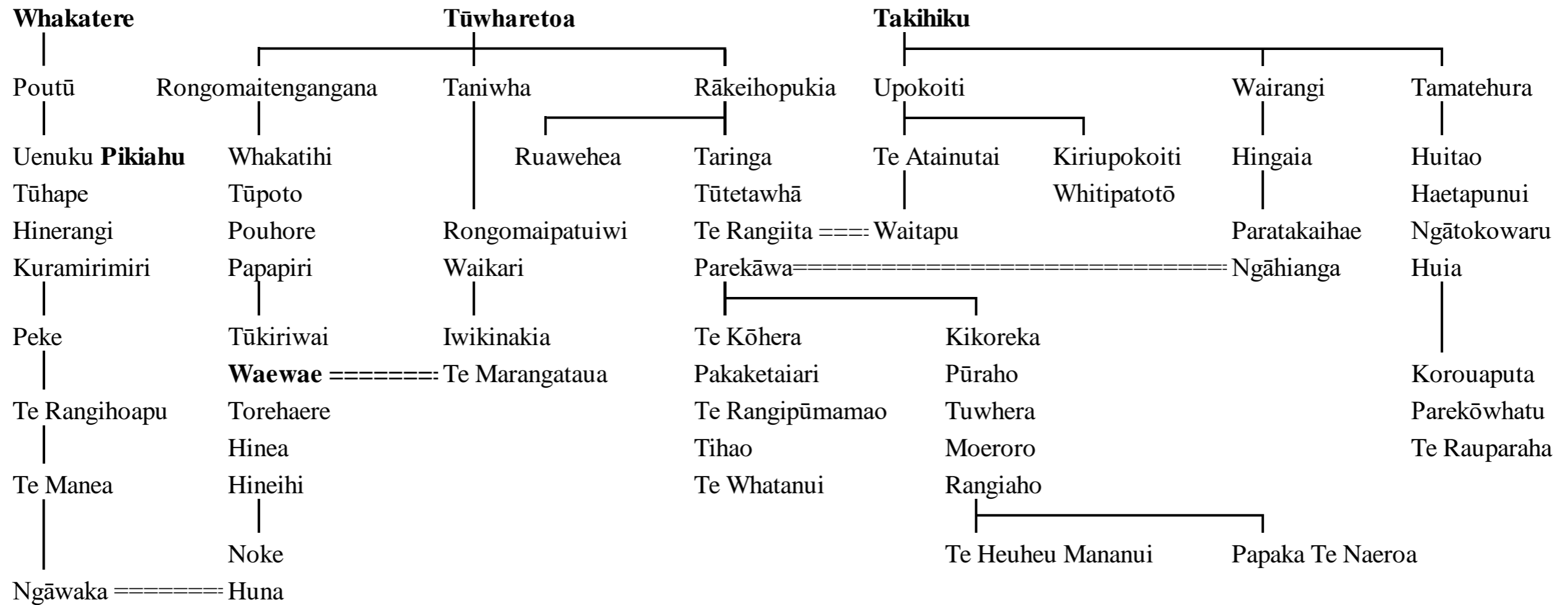


**Whakapapa 5: Kapu<sup>2</sup> and Ngātokowaru**

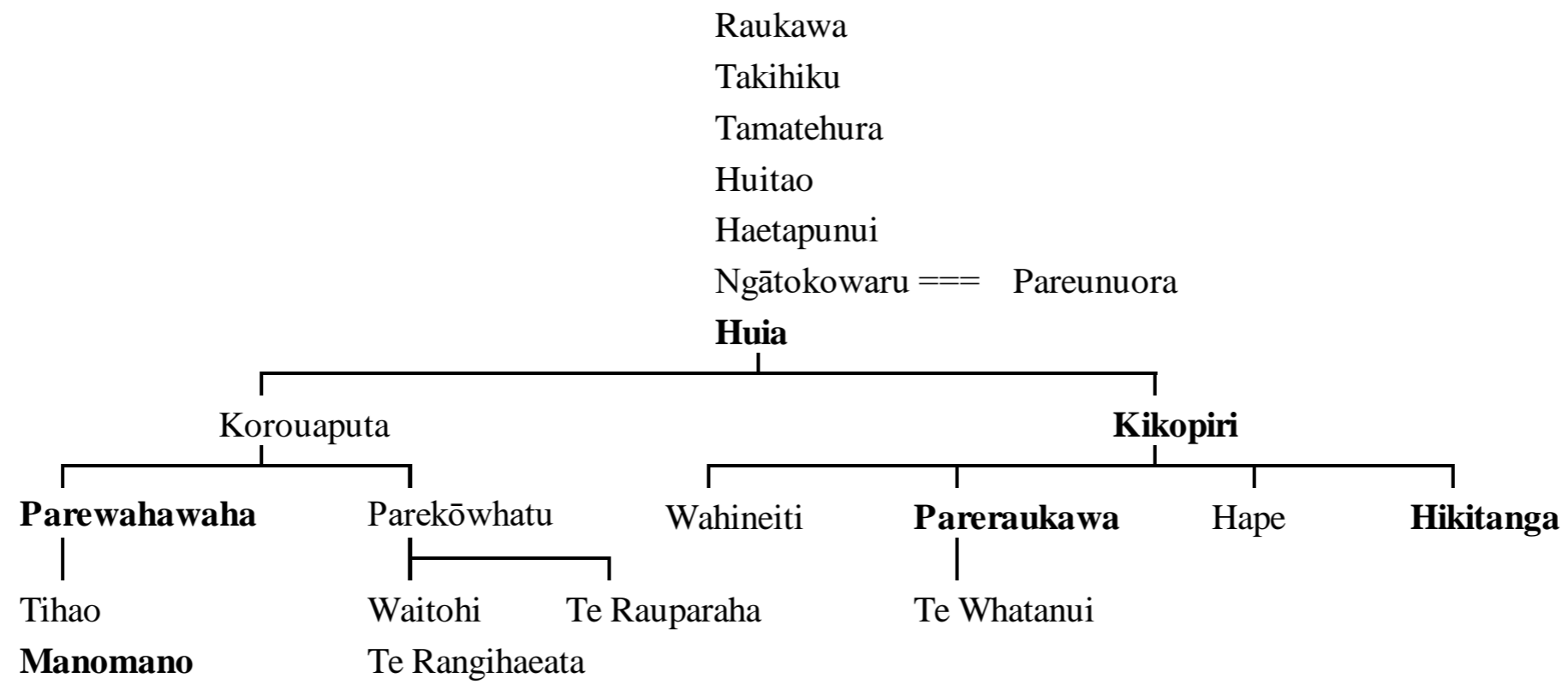


**Whakapapa 6: Matakore and Rangatahi**
